## **Medical Scale Maintenance**



Inspect the entire scale for any obvious signs of damage.



Check the AC adapter for

cracked, frayed cords or

broken, bent prongs.



Change batteries regularly to avoid leaks.

## **Cleaning Your Scale**



Use mild soap and water to clean externally with a damp cloth.



Do not submerge the scale in liquid.



Avoid using Isopropyl alcohol to clean the display surface.

## **Checking Your Scale**



Use NIST Certified test weights to check your scale for accuracy.



Check your scale using 10% of the scale's capacity.



Do not shock load or drop weights onto the scale.
